Shrewsbury-based alt-rock outfit Cosmic Rays are set to release their most honest work to date — Live at the Hare and Hounds, a raw, one-take live EP captured during a show in the summer of 2025. The EP will be available to stream from September 2025.

Known for their blend of soaring melodies, angular guitars, and rhythmic urgency, Cosmic Rays bring an unfiltered energy to this release. Recorded in full, with no overdubs, edits or enhancements, the EP is a bold statement of authenticity in an era of algorithmic perfection.
